B. Discuss location and ideas for DiverseCity Showcase

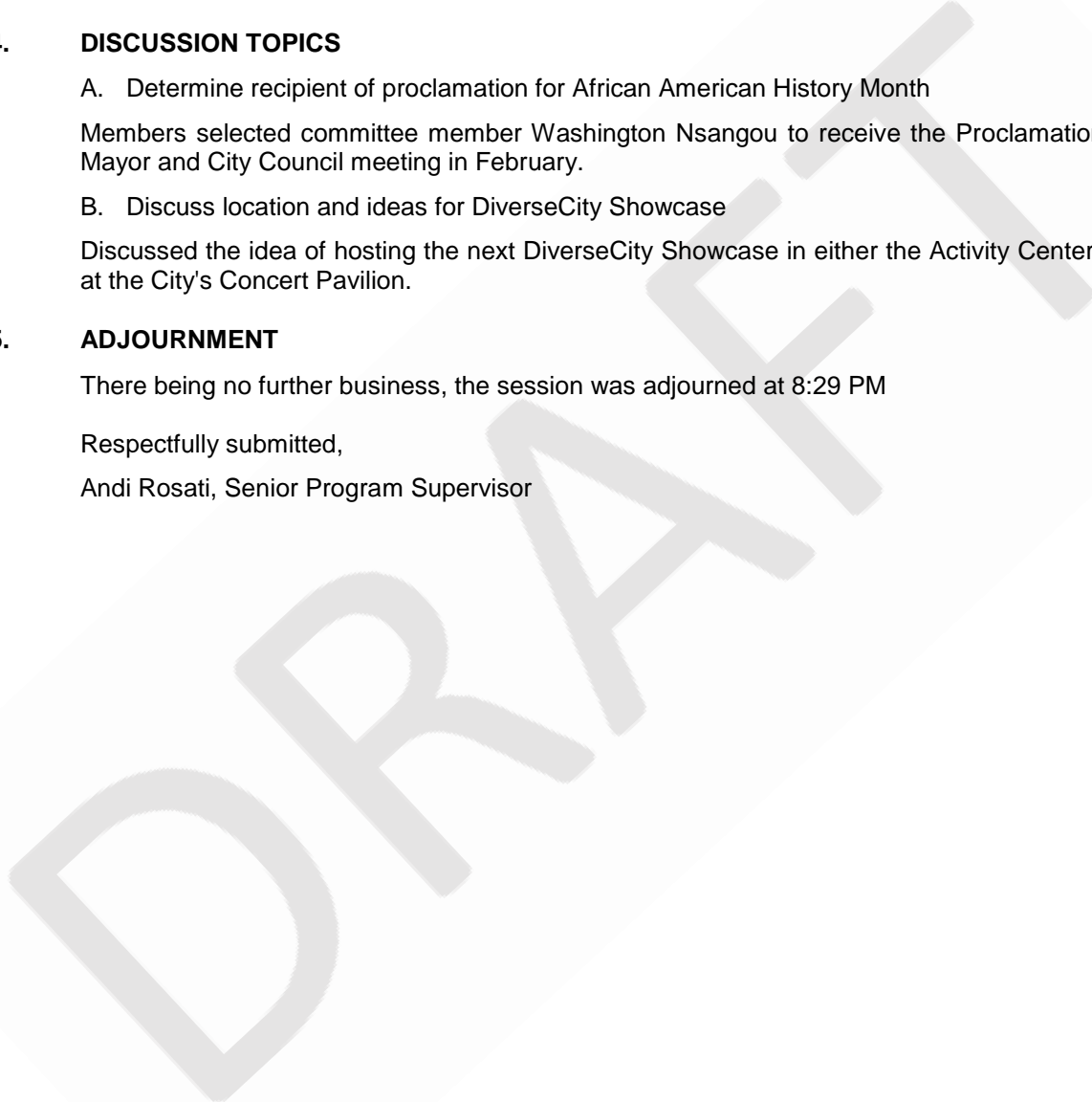
Discussed the idea of hosting the next DiverseCity Showcase in either the Activity Center gym or at the City's Concert Pavilion.
